Meet Razan

Razan is 19 years old and about to start her third year at University. For the past two years, Razan has been a Tylah West Education Scholarship recipient, and this has helped support her through her tertiary years.

'With the support of the scholarship I have been able to purchase my laptop, a bare essential for uni studies. It has helped me to buy text books that cannot be borrowed from the library, vital for exam study. It has helped me to buy a printer, which has made things just that bit easier when studying at home'.

Born in Libya, Razan has been in Australia for most of her life. Her mother, father and older sister have all received scholarships in the past, and this year her younger sibling is also a recipient. 'I think people take education for granted sometimes. The costs can be a real barrier, especially in larger families. With hard work and the help of the scholarship, nearly all of my family are engaged in trades or professional roles now. This benefits the whole community in the long run.'

Razan goes to uni full time and works in Nowra in an Accountancy firm part time, so life is busy. 'I have loved every minute of it. I know my family's future is bright and am very grateful to have been given opportunities and know I will pay this forward in my lifetime'.

2023 will mark the 40th

anniversary of Housing Trust. We are planning some great events and activities for the year ahead and will share more of that with you all early in the new year.

We will also be continuing our advocacy in the lead up to the NSW State Election. We need to ensure that whoever forms government places housing as a priority in the next term. There's some information in the newsletter about how you can get involved and lend your voice to the "Confront the Crisis" campaign. As always a huge thank you to all of you who have shared your stories over the year.

I am thrilled to announce that we've signed an historic agreement with the University of Wollongong (UOW) to establish the "Housing Trust Opportunity Scholarship". The scholarship provides a student with \$5,000 over 3 years of study (\$15,000 total). Recipients must be applying for study at UOW and live in social or affordable housing anywhere in the Illawarra or Shoalhaven. There are more details on how to apply in the newsletter.

The good news keeps on coming for Housing Trust with a number of local and national business and individual awards including 2022 Business Illawarra Awards Outstanding Community Organisation. Without your support, feedback and participation these awards couldn't be possible.

We held another successful Housing Trust Golf Day raising funds for our Tylah West Education Scholarships. This has enabled us to award 27 scholarships. I'd like to thank our sponsors and supporters for making this possible.

A special thank you to our Tenant Advisory Group for their service this year. It is wonderful that this group dedicates time to ensuring our tenants have a voice and ability to influence decisions made by us.

We hope to be able to bring more events and opportunities to connect with each other in 2023.

Are you Cyber Aware?

It is more important than ever to ensure you're cyber aware and your details are secured to the best of your ability.

The ACSC (The Australian Cyber Security Centre) provide a number of resources and lessons on cyber security and awareness. They recommend taking these simple steps today to protect yourself.

- 1. Update your devices
- 2. Set up and perform regular backups
- 3. Turn on multi factor authentication
- 4. Set up secure passphrases (don't use Password 123, making it a long phrase you would know, i.e. ilovetogodancinginspring!!!)
- 5. Recognise and report scams
- 6. Watch out for threats
