Val has lived in the Illawarra for 30 years. After retirement Val found paying market rent a financial burden that was affecting her ability to have a good quality of life. 'The biggest bonus for me though, was the newfound housing security I now had at Central Gardens. I would not have to move again because my rental property was being sold, or the owners wanted to move back in, or the rent went up every six months. I feel safe and settled'.

An avid gardener, Val propagates most of her amazing array of plants. She says the benefits of propagating are many. 'You can create many new plants from one and save money and you can grow plants for friends and

family. Sometimes specific plants are hard to come by in nurseries, so growing from a cutting, you know you are getting exactly the plant you were after'.

Val loves the Community Garden at the complex. 'The fresh air and sunshine is beneficial to our health, as is the physical exercise we get when gardening. It is also a chance to bump into friends and neighbours and have a chat. We share the fresh fruit, vegetables and herbs. It reduces stress and makes us happy'.

One of Val's favourite pastimes is walking every morning with friends and her dog Roxy. I had some surgery a little while back. While the surgery was successful, I really didn't start to feel better until I started regular exercise again. I highly recommend it for everyone, especially as you age. We all need to be proactive in creating good lives for ourselves, and I am very content in where I live and the life I have made'

Corrimal Project

The \$22 million Correa Gardens Development at Robert Street Corrimal is progressing with construction well underway. The crane has been positioned and concrete has been poured for the residential apartments and townhouses.

Our development partners, Traders in Purple, have set up a community notice board at the site as well as a monthly newsletter so local residents are kept informed and know what to expect in the coming weeks. It's early stages yet but we are excited that by the end of next year, so many more people will be housed in safe, affordable, lovely homes.

Births deaths and marriages

The NSW Registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages have developed the Australian Death Notification Service. This enables people with a single online location to notify multiple organisations that someone has passed away.

Together Home



Housing Trust is playing its role in delivering the **NSW Governments** \$36 million Together Home Program. This is part of the Premiers goal of halving street sleeping by 2025 and

providing immediate support to people who have vulnerable housing during the COVID19 pandemic.

Housing Trust is working closely with partners NEAMI and Wollongong Emergency Family Housing to ensure some of our most vulnerable community members have all the help they need to maintain a tenancy and improve their lives. So far 17 people have found homes through the program. For some of our new tenants, this is the first time in many years that they have had a place to call home. Welcome to all of our new tenants
