Congratulations to our 2025 TWES recipients

Congratulations to our 2025 Tylah West Education Scholarship (TWES) recipients. This year, we awarded 42 scholarships, totalling \$35,250.

Now in its 9th year, TWES honours Tylah West, a young Aboriginal trainee at Housing Trust. With support from Tylah's family, the scholarship helps mitigate the cost in pursuing education, training and workplace opportunities.

A special thanks to our major sponsors CommBank, GM3 and donors from our annual Golf Day. Since the scholarship started, we've supported 214 recipients with nearly \$250,000.

This year we had applications from diverse ages and backgrounds including Libyan, Indian, Syrian, Congolese, South African, and Tongan.

Next year marks the 10th anniversary, so stay tuned for big celebrations in Tylah's honour!

Dignity for All

Northsea is Australia's first mixed tenure building to combine commercial, private, social and affordable housing around a single core, with no segregation of lifts, lobbies and shared resident facilities.

Sandra, who has been a HT customer for 12 years, said Northsea was a transformative development.

"This is more than just housing, it is about people, it's about self-esteem, it's about being part of the community, it's about being treated with respect and dignity," she said.

Now working as a mental health peer support worker, Sandra credited stable housing with helping rebuild her life.



"It is the cornerstone of how we live, having housing," decent, affordable housing," she said.

HT chief executive Amanda Winks said the project was "a beacon of hope".

"I hope this is the last time this is seen as an innovation, and I really hope that this is the blueprint for housing moving forward the way that it should be done."





The Bower

9 new homes for women-led households in Dapto

The Bower, has opened its doors in Dapto. This development features nine brand new 1 and 2-bedroom townhouses designed especially for women-led households.

The project was assisted with funding by the Federal Government's \$10 billion Housing Australia Future Fund (HAFF), and through a Wollongong City Council Grant from the Commonwealth Government's Building Better Regional Cities program.

The Bower ensures safe, secure, and affordable housing for over 25 years. We're excited to see the positive impact this will have on our community.

Stop, Check, & Protect

Scams are getting more and more sophisticated and costing Australians billions of dollars each year.

Scam Watch have 3 simple steps can help stop scammers.

STOP: Don't give your money or your information to anyone if unsure.

CHECK: Ask yourself if the message or call is fake.

PROTECT: Act quickly if something feels wrong.

Contact your bank if you notice unusual activity or if you think you've given your details to a scammer. Seek help and report the scam to Scamwatch.

When you report scams, you help stop the scam and warn others.
