Terms and Conditions of Entry

Please read the Terms and Conditions of entry into the Illawarra Community Housing Trust Ltd. Golf Day Fundraiser prior to entry. Your inclusion in this event is subject to you accepting these Terms and Conditions.

This authority is approved under delegation from the Minister administering the *Charitable Fundraising Act 1991*.

Housing Trust is a holder of an Authority to appeal for public funds, subject to the obligations set out in the Charitable Fundraising Act of 1991 (the Act) and the Charitable Fundraising Regulation 2015.

All funds raised will contribute to the Housing Trust Tylah West Education Scholarship Program.

Housing Trust regularly carries out public relations, communication and marketing activities to generate support and maintain a strong profile in the community and raise awareness about community housing. Whilst there is an entry fee into the tournament, there is no entry fee for the major prize. Entry is by invitation only. Raffle tickets are purchased separately to entrance fees and prizes are awarded to the first, second and third place holders at a minimum. Housing Trust staff selling raffle tickets will have identification on them so participants can easily recognise persons with authority to fundraise.

Prizes

Hole in One on 3rd Hole:

If a Housing Trust fundraiser registered amateur golfer hits a hole in one on pin number 3 they will win a brand new car valued at a minimum of \$30,000. This is a Free Lottery as described by NSW Fair Trading and a game of skill. Should more than one person hit a hole in one, there will be a play off.

Each person will have to tee off on the same spot aiming for the same pin, and the person whose ball is closest to the hole will win the car. The length is 203m.

Supervisors/Witnesses/Officials shall be stationed at the selected hole at all times during the Tournament.

SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS: At least one independent supervisor 18 years or older must be present. The Insured is to cover the cost of supervision. Independent shall mean an individual aged 18 years or older who is not a player in the competition, related to or employed by (1) the Insured, (2) the prize supplier or (3) the event organiser AND who is capable of verifying the successful attempt and compliance with terms and conditions of the Policy. Continuous video footage must be taken on the day showing each shot and the flight path to the pin.

No practice shot shall be permitted. Score cards must be completed. The Hole-in-One must occur during officials tournament play by an official player.

Raffles:

There will be numerous prizes raffled on the day. This is a draw lottery and a game of chance. The raffle will be drawn on the day of the fundraiser. The closing of the raffle will be announced on the day. Housing Trust staff may not win raffle prizes. Winners will be randomly drawn near the conclusion of the event. Winners do not have to be present. Housing Trust will provide the prizes to winners within two weeks of the draw if they are not present.

Trophy and prizes:

First prize perpetual trophy will be awarded to the group with the lowest total score. The trophy will be held by the Housing Trust until the following Housing Trust Golf Day Fundraiser. Other prizes may be distributed by Housing Trust on the day.

Second prize will be awarded to the group with the second lowest total score. Prizes may be distributed by Housing Trust on the day.

Third prize will be awarded to the group with the third lowest score. Prizes may be distributed by Housing Trust on the day.
